The Rev. Dr. Kirsi Stjerna is First Lutheran, Los Angeles/Southwest California Synod Professor of Lutheran History and Theology at Pacific Lutheran Theological Seminary in Berkeley. Her book, *Women and the Reformation* (Wiley-Blackwell, 2008), broke new ground by bringing women's theological voices to the conversation. Stjerna co-edited *The Annotated Luther*, Vol. I-VI (Fortress Press, 2015-2017). In 2021 she published *Lutheran Theology: A Grammar of Faith* (Bloomsbury/T&T Clark) for classroom and congregational uses.
